REPORTS

Staff Reports

In addition to the activities found on the attached Clallam Conservation District Staff Reports document:

Meghan Adamire reported providing TA to 6 farms on pasture management. The Clark Creek FFFPP project from 2012 has a bank erosion 20' upstream from the culvert inlet. Toured several CREP sites with Kent Stokes, FSA executive director. And the CNMP for Willow-Wist is nearly complete.

Jennifer Bond provided technical assistance to 7 farms including a horse boarding operation that plans to sell compost. This will require a conservation plan update and that the farmer track volumes, conduct annual testing and provide annual reports to Clallam County Environmental Health. Received several more inquiries regarding cost share for onsite septic systems.

Joe Holtrop reported performing irrigation ditch flow measurements on two Sequim Prairie-Tri Irrigation Association ditches proposed for piping: a portion of the Eureka main across the Boyd property east of River Road, and the Evans Road lateral. For the Eureka ditch, probably only a small portion of the water will have to be given up in order get the project funded. We have \$50,000 from the Natural Resource Investments grant to match Irrigation Efficiencies grant funding and Ecology funding for aquifer recharge.
