

Water-Wise PLANTS

for LANDSCAPING on the NORTH OLYMPIC PENINSULA

The groundcovers, trees, and shrubs listed here are excellent choices for particularly dry sites. Native plants are the best bet because they evolved under local conditions along with the local fauna.

Fall is the ideal time for planting. Plants are going dormant, thus stress is minimal. The soil is still warm enough for roots to begin growing. And, fall rains provide water for good establishment.

For any new planting, mulch heavily and get new plants off to a healthy start to ensure good establishment. Well established plant are more capable of surviving without supplemental watering in subsequent years.

Salal	Gaultheria shallon	evergreen, prefers shade when young, mulch heavily	
Sword Fern	Polystichum munitum	evergreen for shade or part sun	
Twin Flower	Linnaea borealis	sparse evergreen for shade & lots of organic matter	
Wild Ginger	Asarum caudatum	evergreen, prefers shade & lots of organic matter

Blue Fescue	Festuca glauca	short, clumping ornamental grass	
Cotoneaster	Cotoneaster spp.	dammeri & microphyllus are excellent choices	
Creeping Phlox	Phlox subulata	spring bloomer	
Heath	Erica spp.	late winter bloomer	
Heather	Calluna spp.	late summer bloomer	
Hens & Chicks	Sempervivum	very drought-tolerant succulent	
Juniper	Juniperus spp.	various prostrate species, evergreen	
Lithodora	Lithodora diffusa	dark blue blossoms in spring & summer, evergreen	
Ornamental Raspberry	Rubus calycinoides	rapid spreader, sun or shade	
Ornamental Strawberry	Fragaria spp.	red or pink blossomed coastal strawberry hybrid	
Sedums	Sedum spp.	very drought-tolerant succulents	
Sun Rose	Helianthemum nummularium	spring & summer bloomer	
Thyme	Thymus spp.	herbs and ornamentals

Madrona	Arbutus menziesii	broadleaf evergreen, NATIVE	
Pacific Wax Myrtle	Myrica californica	evergreen shrub/small tree, native to SW WA	
Shore Pine	Pinus contorta 'Contorta'	evergreen, NATIVE	
Vine Maple	Acer circinatum	small tree or large shrub, deciduous, NATIVE

California Lilac	Ceanothus spp.	evergreen with fragrant spring blossoms	
Escallonia	Escallonia exoniensis	evergreen, susceptible to extreme cold	
Evergreen Huckleberry	Vaccinium ovatum	evergreen for shade or part sun, NATIVE	
Hazelnut	Corylus cornuta	large shrub or small tree, NATIVE	
Indian Plum	Oemlaria cerasiformis	first to leaf out in late winter, NATIVE	
Juniper	Juniperus spp.	evergreen shrubs and small trees	
Laurustinus	Viburnum tinus 'Compacta'	evergreen, susceptible to extreme cold	
Lavender	Lavandula spp.	fragrant summer bloomer	
Lilac	Syringa vulgaris	fragrant spring bloomer	
Manzanita	Arctostaphylos spp.	evergreen, Hairy Manzanita is Native	
Mockorange	Philadelphus lewisii	early summer bloomer, NATIVE	
Nootka Rose	Rosa nutkana	vigorous thicket former for hedges, NATIVE	
Oceanspray	Holodiscus discolor	early summer bloomer, NATIVE	
Oregon Grape (Tall)	Mahonia aquifolium	thicket former, evergreen, NATIVE	
Potentilla	Potentilla fruticosa	summer bloomer, NATIVE	
Snowberry	Symphoricarpos albus	vigorous thicket former for hedges, NATIVE	
Red-Flowering Currant	Ribes sanguineum	early spring bloomer, NATIVE	
Rock Rose	Cistus x purpureus	may be damaged by extreme winter freezes	
Rosemary	Rosmarinus officinalis	may be damaged by extreme winter freezes	
Serviceberry	Amelanchier alnifolia	large shrub or small tree, NATIVE	
Strawberry Tree (Compact)	Arbutus unedo 'Compacta'	evergreen similar to Madrona	
Thimbleberry	Rubus parviflorus	thicket former, NATIVE
